Motion by MacTavish seconded by Bassett to approve the 2024-2025 Budget as presented. Roll Call Vote: Bassett, aye; MacTavish, aye; Smith, aye; VanWagner, aye; Heckman, aye. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Motion by VanWagner seconded by MacTavish to approve 2024-01 General Appropriations Act Resolution for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Jean Toner and Lori Schussler from Jean's Pizza Café asked for Council approval to host an ATV event on June 22 which includes closing Edgerton from East of Post Office to White Street from 8:00 am – 8:00 pm; a Give Back to the Community Event on August 17 which includes closing Edgerton from 4:00 pm – 9:00 pm; and to extend the Small Business Saturdays (last Saturday of each month) from April – June. Council approved of all events.

Motion by Bassett seconded by MacTavish to pay bills as presented for a total of \$2,413.78. Motion CARRIED (6-0)

Public Comment: Blaine Gebhardt appreciated the approval of the Small Business Saturday's as she stated it brings in a lot of people from outside of Howard City. Mike Smith inquired about the deadline for submitting paperwork to run for Council.
