Mr. Campbell shared a thank you card he received from Off Season's Sports and Wildwood cabin for the grants they received from the DDA. Mr. Falcon and Chairman Campbell also informed the Committee of the grateful responses they received from the grant recipients.
Mr. Pease inquired about the maintenance on the walking path along Shaw Street and stated it looks very nice and he was happy to see maintenance being performed.
Mr. Falcon informed the Committee that Shaw Street is scheduled to begin chip sealing on Monday, August 10. This project may take up to a couple of weeks to complete. Additionally, he stated that for safety concerns the three lanes at the traffic light of Ensley and Shaw will be changed to two lanes (a straight and right turn only lane and a left turn lane) when the chip sealing is complete.
Signage was discussed regarding traffic exiting Wonderland Tire onto Shaw Street. It is beilived that there should be a turn right only sign posted there. Mr. Baker also inquired about wrong-way signs on the one-way streets to raise awareness.
